PURPOSE OF THE RTA WINTER 2022 REGIONAL LEADERSHIP TOUR TO SOUTH FLORIDA

The RTA business leadership group has conducted a number of visits to other markets since 2005 to create shared opportunities for discovery, reflection, insight, and momentum. Past tours have included San Diego, Denver, Dallas, Austin, Cleveland, Pittsburgh, Washington, Baltimore, Richmond, Minneapolis, Indianapolis, and more.

Currently the Triangle has active projects for 50+ miles of bus rapid transit (BRT), 40+ miles of commuter rail, multimodal pathways including the Triangle bikeway, transit-oriented development, equitable placemaking, and transit innovations, with many supported by approved countywide ½-sales taxes that are dedicated for transit.

We believe the RTA Regional Leadership Tour to South Florida — which will include briefings and visits to Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach counties — will inform and inspire ongoing progress on our Accelerated Metropolitan Mobility strategy and agenda for the Research Triangle region.
